A “Fireside Chat”

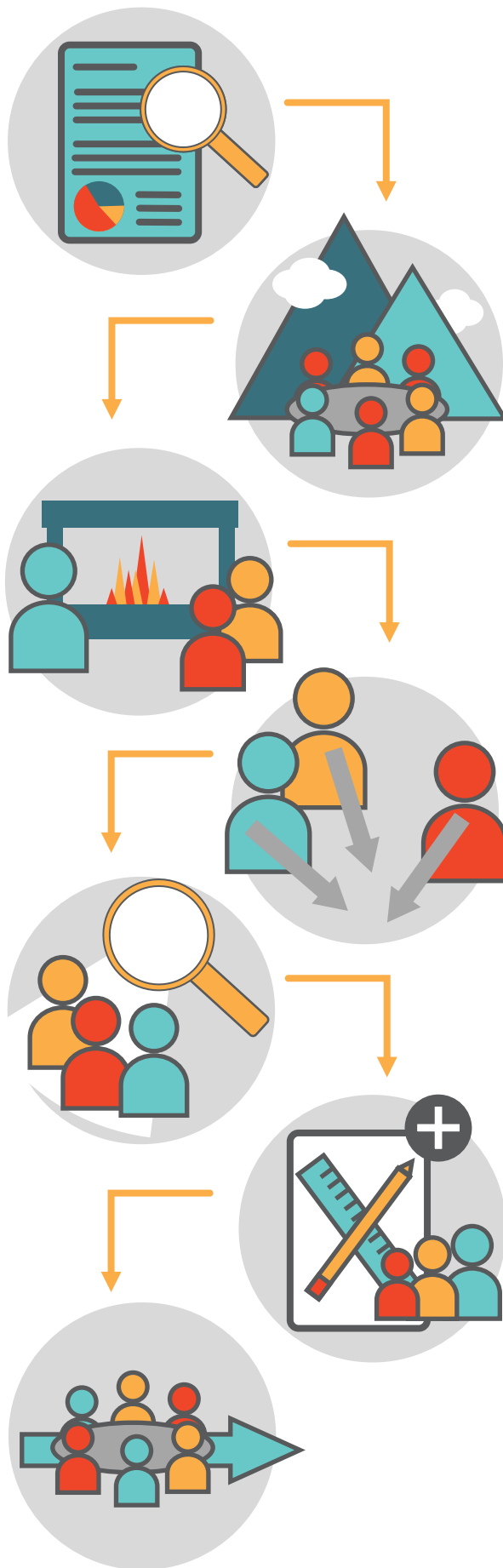
Post-Summit we invited Susan Dreyfus, CEO of the AFC back for an intimate conversation with members about the things that keep us up at night—and what we can do about them!
